The waters here are teeming with schools of angelfish, colorful parrotfish, Nassau groupers up to four feet long and Queen conch, an icon in the Bahamas. You might even spot playful bottlenose dolphins and sea turtles. All species of sea turtles in the Bahamas are protected and each year their numbers increase.
