ITINERARY

October 27 Arrive in Rome and transfer to The Hoxton hotel. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure.

October 28 After breakfast, set out on an exciting tour of Vatican City, the smallest city-state in the world. Explore the vast collection of art and glorious treasures in the Vatican Museums, marvel at the Sistine Chapel's breathtaking ceiling, and admire the largest church in the world, the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica. Those who do not join in the optional excursion will spend the afternoon at leisure.

OPTIONAL: Tivoli & Villa d'Este Excursion, \$179 per person Travel beyond the bustle of Rome to explore Tivoli, known for its Villa d'Este— a captivating garden complex. Once a Benedictine monastery and now a UNESCO World Heritage site, the villa is adorned with impressive waterfalls and more than five hundred fountains.

October 29 After breakfast, set out on a half-day sightseeing excursion that highlights some of Rome's most celebrated attractions. Begin with a tour of Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, an impressive church that houses the tomb of Saint Paul. Immerse yourself in its spiritual ambiance and admire the stunning mosaics that adorn its walls. Afterward, continue on Ostiense Road, past the Pyramid Caius Cestius, St. Paul's Gate, the Baths of Caracalla and the Circus Maximus, the site of ancient chariot races. Next enjoy an interior visit of the Colosseum, one of the world's most iconic landmarks. As you stroll around, you'll be transported back in time to the days of gladiator battles and spectacles. Next, walk past the Roman Forum, a sprawling archaeological site that was once the center of political and social life in ancient Rome. As the tour comes to a close, transfer to *Vista* to embark on your cruise.

***TRANSFERS:** Airport transfers are only applicable during program dates. Transfers are only provided to Rome's (FCO) airport.

MOBILITY STATEMENT: Travelers should be confident in their ability to walk and stand for a minimum of 5 hours with a total of 2-4 miles per day while keeping a steady pace with a group or tour guide. This tour can involve walking on uneven ground for extended periods and occasionally stairs, some without handrails. Travelers should be able to board a coach or tour bus independently. This tour is not recommended for those with a walker or wheelchair. **LOCAL CUSTOMS:** Local customs require covering knees and shoulders when visiting religious sites.
