## ITINERARY

**February 19** Arrive in Bangkok and transfer\* to the four-star Centara Life Hotel Bangkok Phra Nakhon or similar accommodations. Check in and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure, allowing time to relax or explore the surrounding area independently.

**February 20** After breakfast, embark on a full-day excursion to Ayutthaya, the historic former capital of Thailand. Visit the Arts of the Kingdom Museum, showcasing exquisite Thai craftsmanship, and explore the ancient ruins of Wat Mahathat, famous for its iconic Buddha head entwined in tree roots. Conclude the day with a scenic return journey to Bangkok via the Chao Phraya River aboard the Grand Pearl Cruiser, enjoying an included lunch while taking in the riverside views.

**February 21** Begin the day with a half-day tour of Bangkok's cultural treasures. Experience a tuk-tuk ride to the Grand Palace, an architectural masterpiece and home to the revered Emerald Buddha. Continue to Wat Pho to admire the impressive Reclining Buddha. As the tour comes to a close, transfer to Laem Chabang to embark on your cruise aboard *Sirena*.
